Port Douglas Yacht Club Inc invites entries to compete in the 2021 Keith Quinn Memorial Race.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Race will be governed by the rules, as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021 2024.

 Australian Sailing Special Regulations Category 5, and the Sailing Instructions (SI).
- 1.2 Racing rules 26, 32-34 will be changed as follows: 26 Starts will be using GPS time, 32-34 Signals shall be made by radio call.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the club.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 All registered sailboats may enter online via https://app.sailsys.com.au/club/8/entry?tab=entry.
- 2.2 The skipper must, and crew should, be members of an Australian Sailing affiliated club, RRS 46 applies.

 Advice on adding crew to your crew list is available, all crew need to be listed on the boat entry.

3. DIVISIONS

- 3.1 All boats race in Division 1 using the SailSys Performance Handicap System.
- 4 SCHEDULE OF RACES
- 4.1 Racing is scheduled for Sunday 8th August 2021.
- 4.2 Registration at, or prior to, race briefing at 08:30 at PDYC on day of racing.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 10:10.
- 4.3 The schedule may change depending on the forecast conditions.
- 4.4 Postponed races will be rescheduled or abandoned as circumstances dictate.

5. COURSE

5.1 Passage race to be determined at race briefing from the courses listed below.

6. RADIO COMMUNICATION

6.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. All boats to monitor Channel 72 at all times afloat.

7. PRIZES

- 7.1 Boats race for the Keith Quinn Memorial Trophy (to remain at PDYC) and prizes for placings.
- 7.2 Presentation of prizes and social drinks will follow conclusion of racing at Port Douglas Yacht Club.
- 7.3 Points count towards the PDYC Club Championship.

8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

8.1 Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS, Rule 3, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

9 INSURANCE

9.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of five million per incident or the equivalent.
